In Regards to Visiting Teams**

The Gordon College Athletic Training staff would like to welcome all visiting teams which our athletic teams will play during their 2005 – 2006 athletic seasons. When your teams visit Gordon the following services will be provided to your teams.

1) A Certified Athletic Trainer will be present at all home events with a student trainer there to assist. In addition a public safety officer/ EMT, who we are directly connected with, will always be available to assist with emergency. The training room, which is located next to the gym on the back of the Bennett Center, will be open for treatment prior to games
