We are interested in candidates who can teach undergraduate and graduate courses in special education and early childhood education. Some practicum supervision is required. All faculty members teach the equivalent of 12 hours per semester (3 courses) and maintain active scholarly work in their field. Faculty members also have advising and committee service responsibilities.

The successful candidate will hold a Ph.D. or Ed.D. in education and a serious, personal Christian commitment that is reflected in their scholarship, teaching and mentoring of undergraduate students.
