\square Two letters of recommendation speaking to the candidate's success as a music educator
☐ Three to four page essay on the candidate's philosophy of music education
\square One official transcript from each undergraduate and graduate institution attended
\square 30 minute DVD demonstration of the candidate teaching a music class or rehearsal
☐ Interview with program director
Please note: A graduate grade point average of 2.85 or higher is required. Students with promise but less than a 2.85 graduate grade point average may be admitted on a provisional status.
