We welcome candidates to develop courses and teach in our growing Master of Public Health (MPH) online program. We are particularly interested in faculty with expertise in Epidemiology, Biostatistics, Health Policy, and Healthcare Management. Available courses may include, but are not limited to, the following:

This is a remote position. Courses are generally 8 weeks and delivered asynchronously; however, candidates will be required to offer a minimum of 1 hour weekly synchronous sessions for each course they teach.

The ideal candidate will have:

- a doctorate in public health or other relevant field or a master's degree combined with significant work experience related to public health
- a demonstrated mature Christian faith, strong commitment to the Christian mission of the College, and agreement with the school's [Statement of Faith](#)
- a passion for teaching and mentoring students
- experience teaching in higher education with preference given to those who have taught in online environments.

Interested applicants must submit a Curriculum Vita that includes the names of two references and a letter of application addressing their fit with the Christian mission of Gordon College and the position listed above.
