## Italian VISA requirements & application instructions

The Global Education Office will apply for the VISA required for your stay in Orvieto. In order for us to do this, you must provide us with the following:

- A total of 8 Official Passport Photos
- Up-to-date Passport—must be signed, be valid for six months after the last day of your stay in Italy, have a minimum of 3 open/unused pages. Passports must be sent to the Global Education Office (via FEDEX or registered mail) by Nov 10<sup>th</sup> —we will return it to you via FEDEX overnight service once they are received back from the Italian Consulate.
- The Schengen Visa application form included in the Acceptance Packet, completed neatly and legibly in block letters (uppercase) using black ink, following carefully the instructions below, with *No Cross Outs* or writing over words.

<u>Place and date</u>: the town where signed (hence for Gordon students it will most likely be Wenham, MA) and date signed

Signature: your signature should match the signature on your passport!
